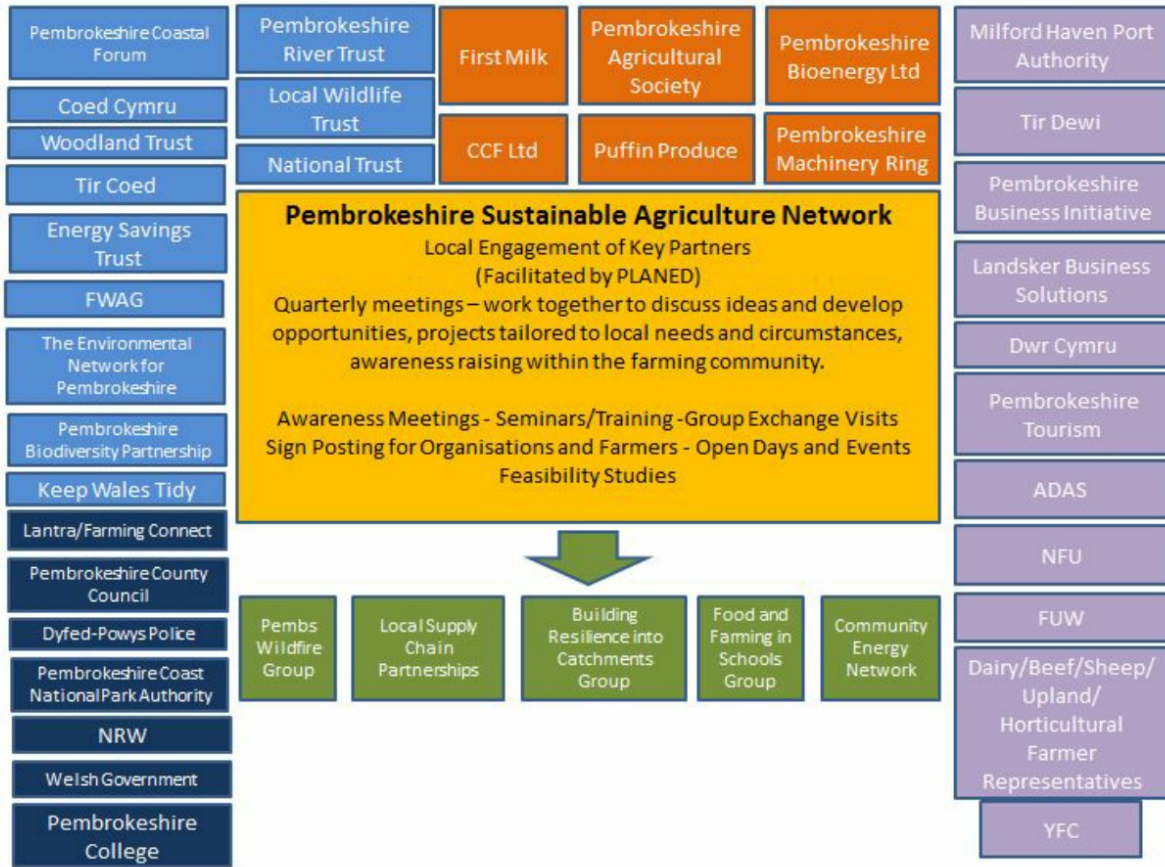




# Pembrokeshire Sustainable Agricultural Network



## Summary

PLANED supported by key partner organisations (FUW, NFU, PCNPA) established in 2006 a forum (Pembrokeshire Sustainable Agriculture Network). The aim of the Network is to bring farming/environmental organisations and farmers in Pembrokeshire together to identify, discuss and take forward new ideas and opportunities e.g. positive land management, renewable energy linked to Sustainable Agriculture.

It is not PLANED's aim to duplicate the excellent work of others in Pembrokeshire who work in this sector but strengthen linkages, add value and compliment existing schemes whilst 'filling in the gaps' where identified by the Network.

## Feedback from Network Partners

42% attend to network with likeminded colleagues/organisations

52% of organisations attend to discuss and receive information relating to sustainable agriculture

28% benefit from the influence of policymakers and management of projects

31% like to update other organisations about projects/schemes
